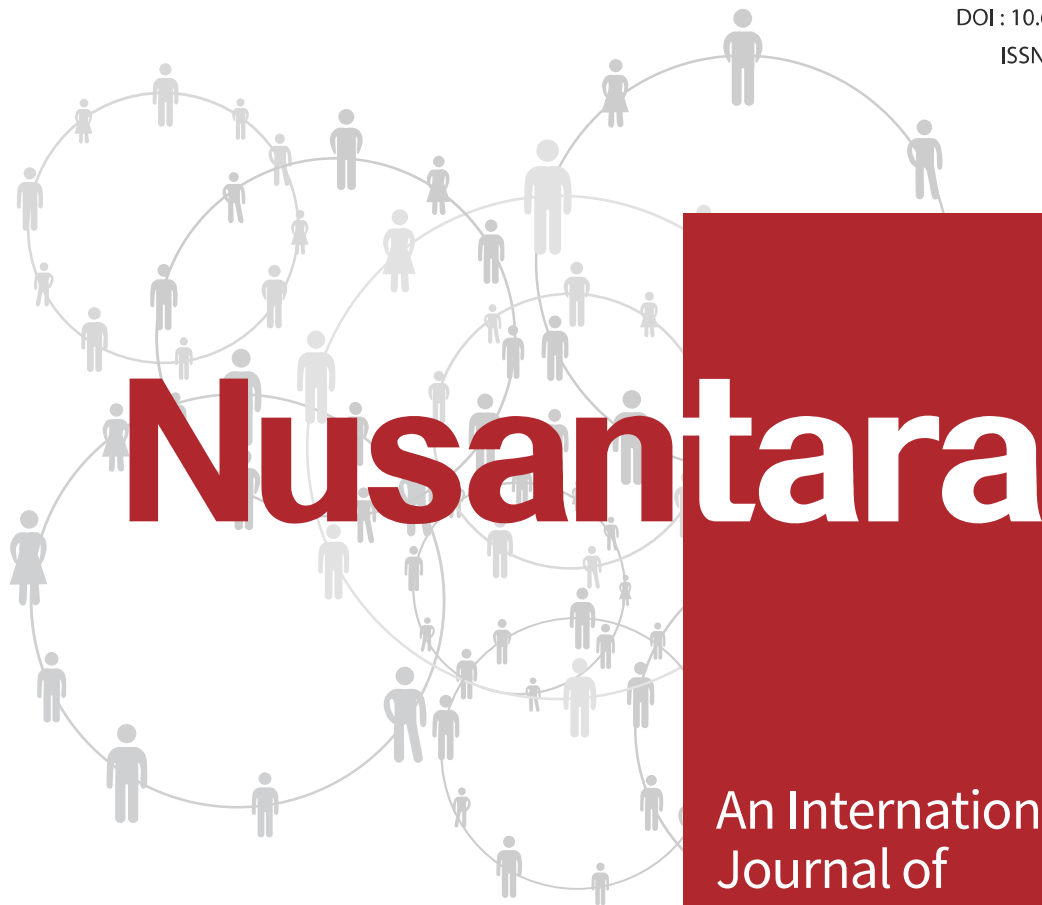

- Language: English (American spelling).

- Manuscript Style: APA (Publication Manual of the American Psychological Association, 6th ed., 2010).
- Manuscript Length: 4,000–6,000 words.
- Font: Times New Roman, font size 12.
- Abstract Length: 500 words, 3–5 keywords.
- References must add DOI number, if provided.
- Manuscript submission in Microsoft Word format.
