

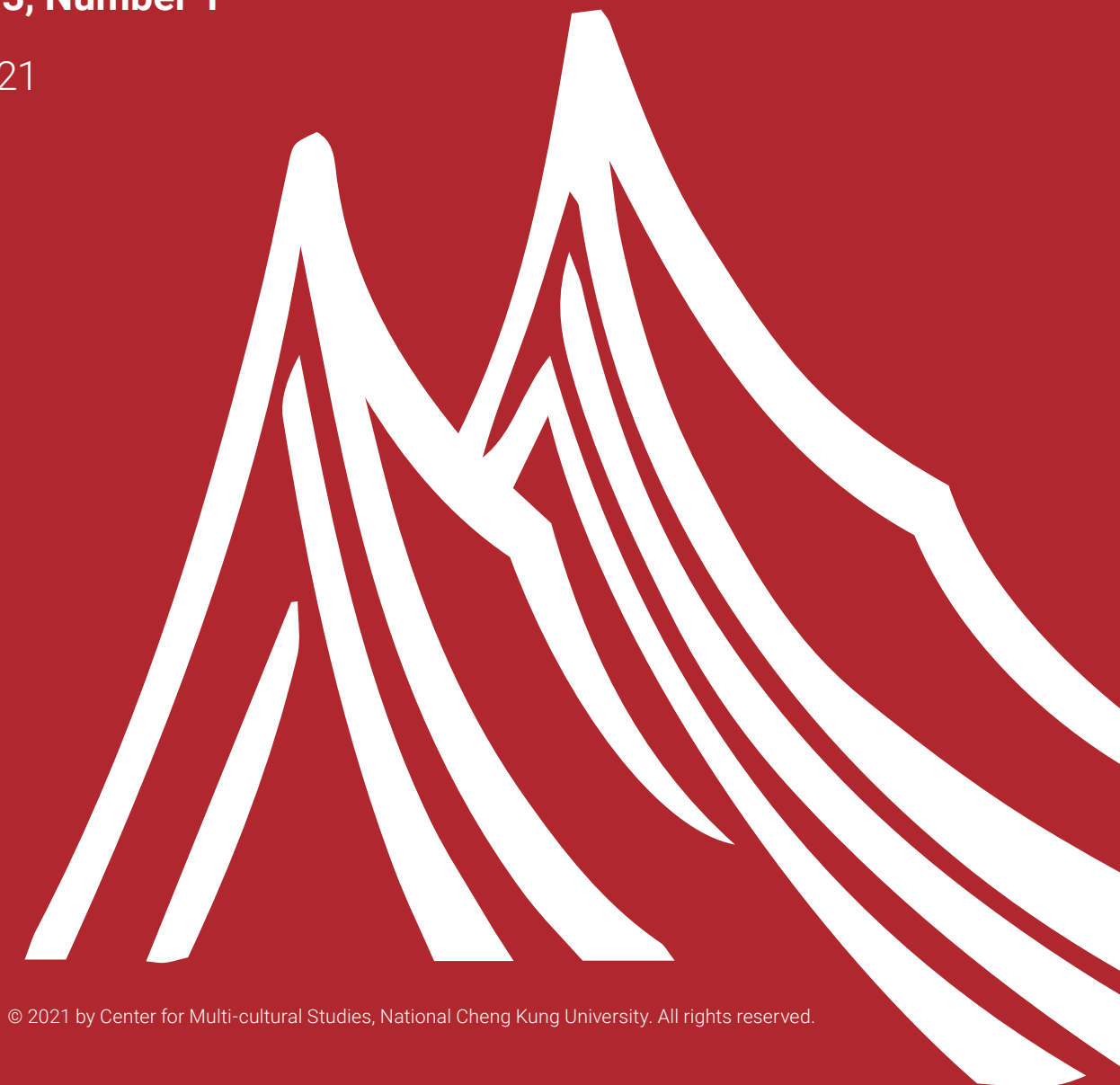

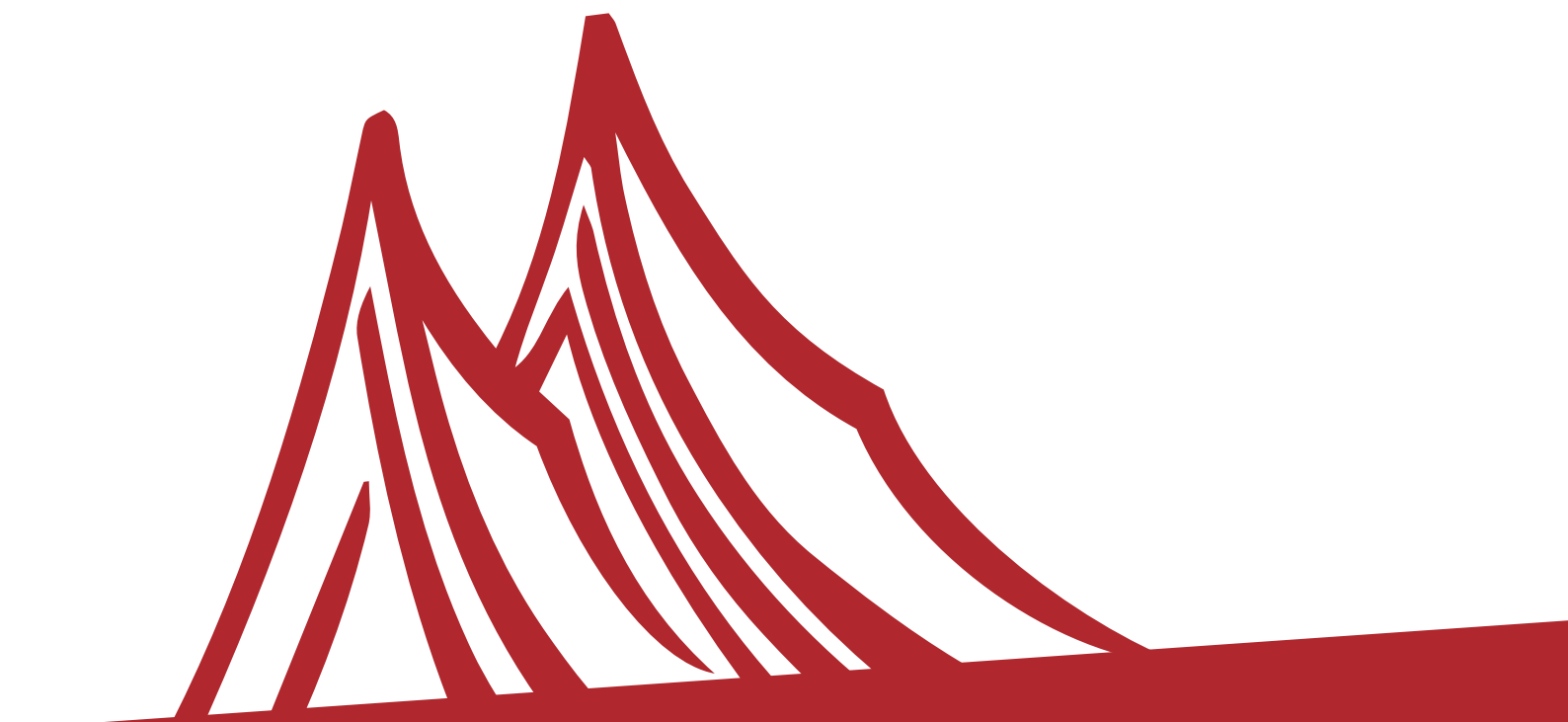

- **Language:** English (American spelling and punctuation)
- **Manuscript Style:** APA 7th edition (Publication Manual of the American Psychological Association, 2020)
 - References must add DOI number or URL, if available
- **Manuscript Length:** 4,000–6,000 words
- **Abstract Length:** 500 words, 3–5 keywords
- **Font:** Georgia, 10 pt. size
- **Submission Format:** Microsoft Word document (.doc/.docx)
