

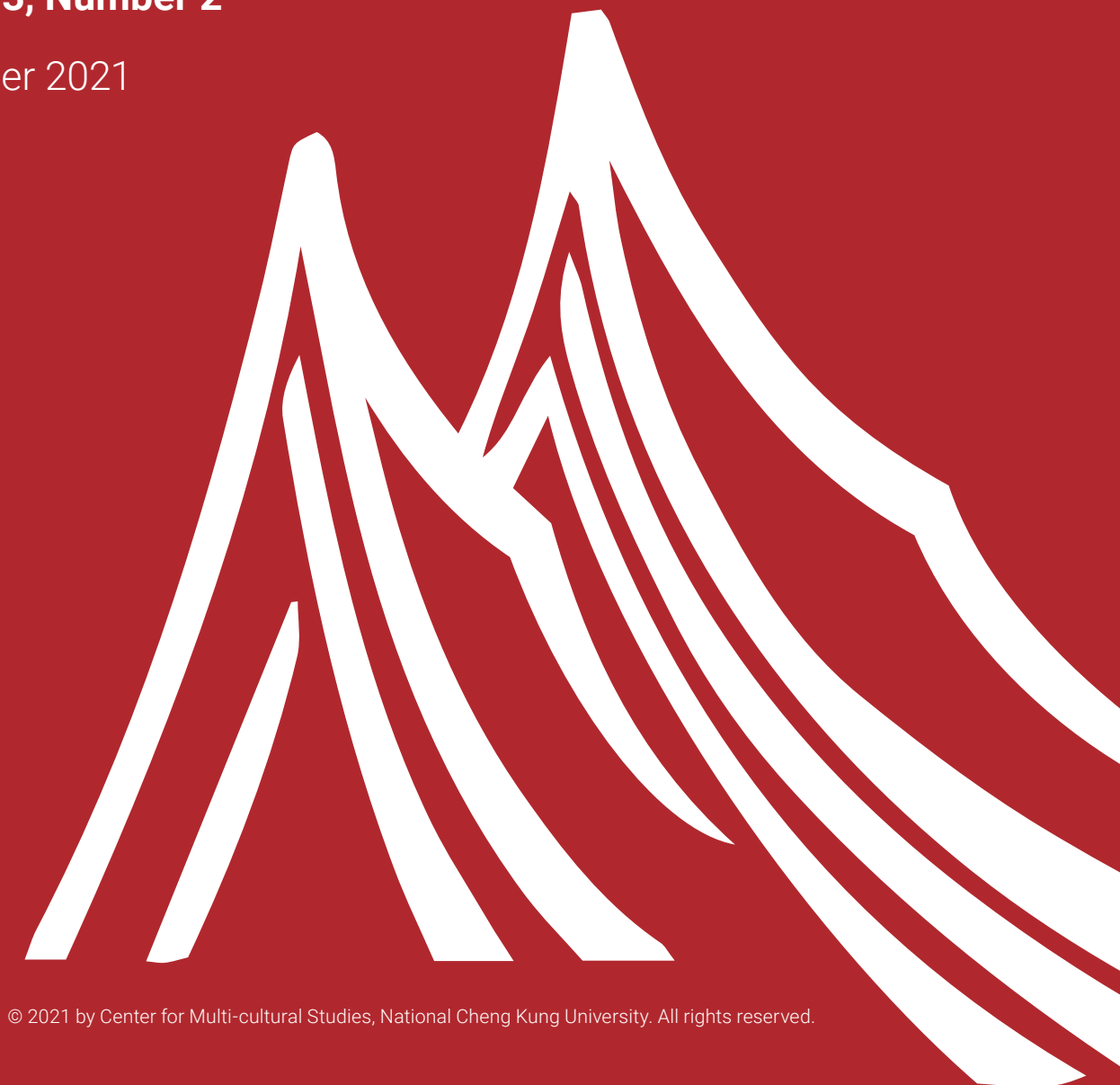

### 2 Practical Information

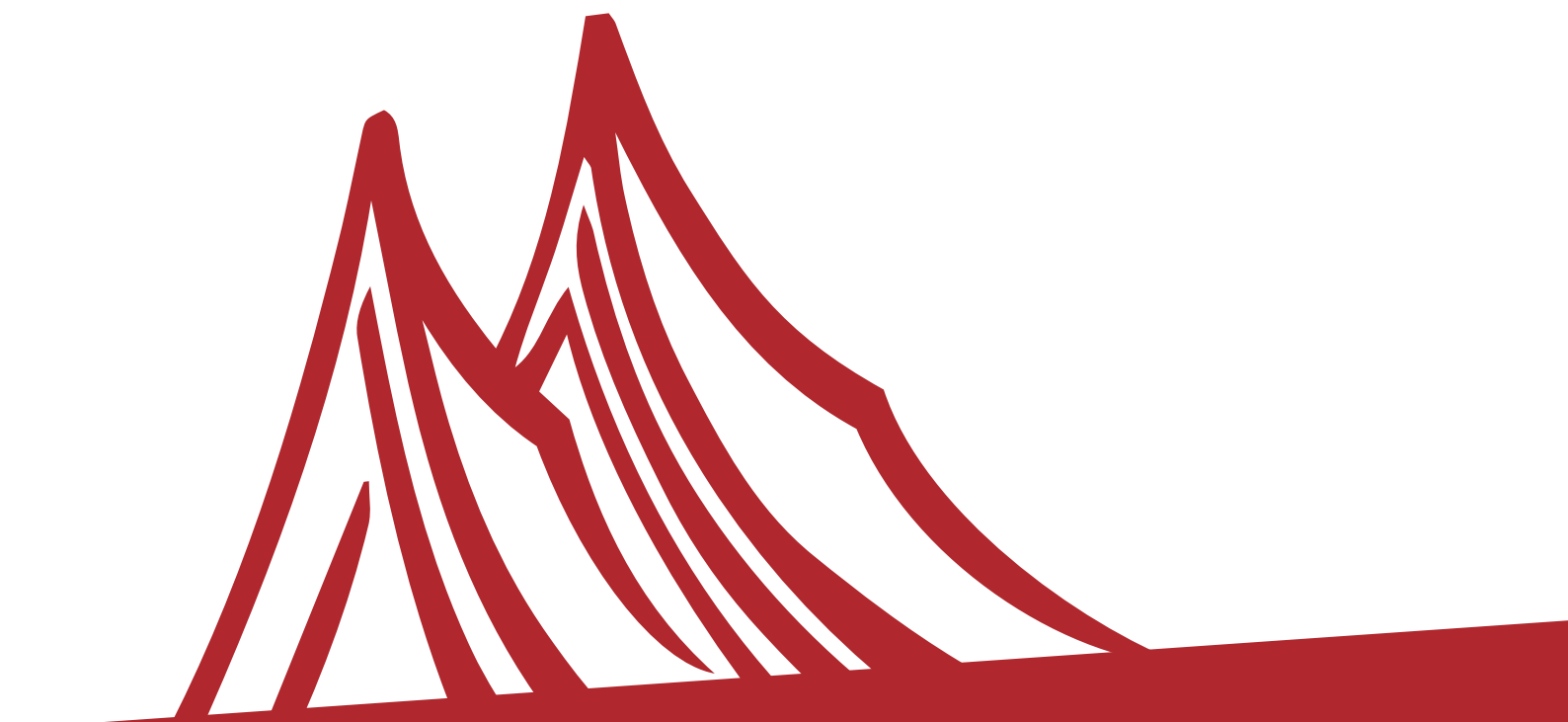

- **Abstract Length:** 500 words, 3–5 keywords
- **Font:** Georgia, 10 pt. size
- **Submission Format:** Microsoft Word document (.doc/.docx)
